There is a fair amount of work involved in the selection of paper stock, font, message, colors and other decisions that go into a baby announcement card. You can do all of this before the baby is born and that will save you a ton of time. After the baby comes home from the hospital, all you need to do is add the picture and tell the printer to let it rip. You can even have the entire mailing list are down file at your card printing shop before baby arrives.

I thought this was a great trick and a great timesaver for new parents. When baby first comes home from the hospital things will be chaotic. And the last thing you'll want to think about are the logistics behind sending out baby announcements to your friends and family. To use this trick and have everything set except for the picture and you will save valuable time and get valuable sleep while still keeping your loved ones informed about the new member of your family.
