What is an RSS directory? RSS stands for Really Simple Syndication. A directory of RSS feeds is a list of RSS feed that you can find on the internet.

An RSS directory allows you to search feed items for keywords. Another way to use an RSS directory is to search for RSS feed topics. An RSS directory can also give you a list of RSS directory owners.

An RSS directory is like a library that contains various categories and subcategories for different websites. Some common RSS feeds found in an RSS directory include education, arts, science, reference, and regional. There is an endless list of RSS feeds that can be found in an RSS directory.

An RSS directory will have an owner. The owner allows you to submit your RSS feed and then decides where to place the feed within the RSS directory.

Listing your RSS feed in an RSS directory can increase the amount of traffic visiting your website. By providing keywords in an RSS directory, you allow users to find exactly what they are looking for. An RSS directory lets you search for website RSS feeds rather than searching for a specific word. Using an RSS directory saves you time because you are looking for specific feeds rather than specific words.

There are hundreds of website on the internet that can teach you about RSS feeds and how to use an RSS directory. RSS directories allow you to list your RSS feeds by keywords, by category, by author, or by owner.

When you add your RSS feed to an RSS directory, it is a good idea to provide a link to the directory on your website. This helps to increase traffic to your website as well as to the RSS directory, which in turn leads to more RSS entries in the RSS directory and greater search power.
